

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ON-GOING USE OF CLUB AND COURSE

Hi All Members,

Following a meeting of club management on 23/03/20, Government directives will now be implemented to ensure the club is compliant under the law.

With that in mind, Management is very keen to still offer as much opportunity as possible for golfers to use the course and maintain golf activity.

It must be emphasized that the initiatives detailed below could change at any time. It is essential that individuals enforce their own social distancing and follow the procedures we have in place. Failure to do so may jeopardize golf activity for everybody.

What will happen as of Tuesday March 24th:

- As the clubhouse is a licensed facility it must be closed. This will include the golf shop.
- Members will be free to use the course for pay-as-you-play games and the fee (Members) will be as usual - \$3 for 9 holes and \$5 for 18 holes. If you wish to have your card entered for handicapping an additional \$1 is to be paid.
- Cards will be available on the shelf outside the shop window. All money is to be placed in supplied small brown envelope, your name should be clearly written on it and it should then be put in the Yellow Honesty box.
For handicapping - card will be matched to the money envelope - no name - no handicapping.
- A similar process will apply for Competitions.
- Cards will be printed at approx 7:45am on the morning of competition and placed on ledge outside shop window. Late registrations will have to use a normal card.
- The competition will be as normal - but with no nearest-the-pin or Saturday poke.
- Fee will be \$8 for Wednesday and Sunday 18 hole comps and \$10 for Saturday 18 Hole comp. It is anticipated that other club competitions such as the Eclectic, Jim Dawson Memorial etc. will still be on.
- As above - money will be placed in envelope with your name then placed in Honesty Box. There will be NO EFTPOS facility, so please bring CASH. Multiple names and correct cash can be placed in one envelope.
- When you finish the round drop your card in the card box outside. Results will be processed and posted online and effect your handicap.
- Players will not be able to purchase anything from the shop and are advised to NOT socialise and leave as soon as possible.
- PLEASE DO NOT CONGREGATE IN THE OUTSIDE AREA. IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO MAINTAIN DISTANCE. If concerned health wise DO NOT ATTEND.
- Carts will still be available for hire - (at this stage!)
- During play - Do not remove flag, or hold with gloved hand or towel. Similarly when raking bunker use glove or towel, or use club or foot to smooth/repair divot.

These are trying and unprecedented times and heavy penalties apply for clubs and individuals disregarding new legislation.

Please help us as we try to protect your wellbeing, enable your enjoyment of the club and ensure its on-going viability.
