



Golf Australia communication regarding COVID-19 for Whyalla Golf Club



Dear South Australian Golf Clubs and Facilities,

As you are aware, COVID-19 or the Coronavirus as it is more commonly known has created global health concerns regarding the disease and its infection rates.

Golf Australia is writing to provide further assistance and guidance to our clubs and facilities on this important topic. The State Government published a new Public Activities Direction (No 14) on Monday 30 November.

Per the direction, clubs may operate in the following manner as of 12:01am Tuesday 1 December:

Golf Operations

Clubs & facilities may return to competition golf

Clubs & facilities are required to prevent the use of shared equipment, or thoroughly clean equipment between each use. The COVID-19 play management guidelines continue to be available and can be found [HERE](#).

Hospitality Operations

Clubs must have a COVIDSafe plan in place.

If your club has not completed a plan to date, complete it [HERE](#).

While there is no cap on the total number of patrons, density rules must be followed:

1 person per 4 square metres rule applies to indoor sections. 1 person per 2 square metres rule applies to outdoor sections.

While indoors, food and beverage must be consumed seated, when outdoors or within a private function room, food and beverage can be consumed while standing.

COVID-Safe Check-in

Patrons must check-in even if they are only using the course.

Clubs will receive their new COVID Safe Plan via email with a unique QR code poster. This poster should be printed and displayed in a prominent location.

Patrons can scan the code using the mySA GOV app or their smartphone camera.

Clubs must also provide hard copy contract tracing forms for those who do not have access to a smart phone, a template can be found [HERE](#).
